### INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GEOHERITAGE AND GEOTOURISM (ICGG 2010)

14-17 October 2010, Lisbon, Portugal



#### **“Using Geodiversity and Geoheritage for Tourism and Sustainable Development”**

Geotourism is a developing branch of research and of applied research to planning and management at local, regional and national levels. Strongly connected with the geodiversity and geoheritage of the land (geo), it also embraces the cultural values (tangible or intangible ones) of the local communities.

Many researchers has already worked in these issues under different names such as ecotourism, tourism of nature, natural trails, geoconservation, geopreservation, georestoration, geoecology, geoparks, geotopes, geosites, geomorphosites, natural heritage, nature conservation, protected areas, landscapes or natural monuments and other designations.

We hope that all those who worked in Geodiversity, Geoheritage, Geotourism or Cultural Heritage, with the aim to contribute to the sustainable development of specific areas, see in this Conference an opportunity to present its experiences and exchange ideas.

## Abstracts

The abstract paper should be presented on an A4 format, with the title in capitals, the name of the authors (first the last names then the initials of the surnames) all in capitals, the professional address with emails, all centered.

The text should have a **minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 400 words** (about 2500 characters), with 3-5 key-words, formatted as a Word Document, in Times New Roman font, 11, space 1, and lateral spaces of 2,5.

The Scientific Committee will examine the abstracts and the acceptance/rejection of these will be communicated to the first author till 30<sup>th</sup> July 2010. The accepted abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts that will be distributed to the registered persons during the Conference.

Deadline for abstracts is **25<sup>th</sup> July 2010**. The submitted abstracts must be accompanied by the registration form a payment proof.

Every author can choose between the two presentation forms: oral or poster presentation. However the organization of the Conference will have the final decision about the presentation forms due to scientific and logistic reasons.

**Conference dinner:** The Conference dinner is not included in the registration fee. The price is fixed in **50€** each person and should be paid together with the registration fee. The restaurant is located in Alfama, the most typical quarter of the old Lisbon, side by side to the first wall of the city. Inside we can see some archeological materials and reconstructions of the wall. During the dinner we will have a private spectacle of Portuguese fado and folklore.

**Field Trip:**

The field trip will last for 2 days (16<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> October) and will departure from the conference meeting point, in Lisbon, the 16<sup>th</sup> in the morning and return to the same place the 17<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon.

For more detailed information see the conference website ([www.icgg2010.com](http://www.icgg2010.com)). But an overall idea is to see some geomorphosites in limestone areas of central Portugal.

In the first day we will go to an area near Coimbra town, the Sicó Massif, and then, coming southwards, to the Estremadura Limestone Massif (ELM), where is located the Candeeiros and Aire Montains Natural Park. We will spend the night in the town of Fátima where is situated the well known sanctuary built in a doline kast landform.

In the second day, besides observing some geomorphosites in the ELM that contribute to the local strategy of geotourism development, we will also visit some touristic coastal areas of Central Portugal. One of these areas is Nazaré, where is located a major tectonic fault with a big importance in geology and geomorphology. The other area is near Peniche: the tombolo of Baleal and the geomorphosites near the Cabo Carvoeiro lighthouse.

## Accommodation in Lisbon:

There are a lot of hotels and residences in Lisbon. The more interesting ones are those near the metropolitan stations because the Conference will take place in the building of the University of Lisbon Rectory (Reitoria da Universidade de Lisboa), that has a metro station (Cidade Universitária).
